




MOSQUITO-BORI

This door hanger is to let you know that your area has been inspected and treated for mosquitoes. We are protecting the community from the recent upsurge of three mosquito-borne illnesses:

>> DENGUE FEVER - Caused by the dengue virus and transmitted to humans by the bite of an infected mosquito. Symptoms include fever, headache, muscle and joint pain and a skin rash similar to measles. A more severe form of the dengue infection is dengue hemorrhagic fever, an affliction that can be fatal if not managed properly.

>> CHIKUNGUNYA - Virus is transmitted to people by the infected mosquitoes. The most common symptoms of chikungunya virus infection are fever and joint pain. Other symptoms may include headache, muscle pain, joint swelling, or rash. Symptoms usually begin 3–7 days after being bitten.

>> WEST NILE VIRUS - An arthropod-borne virus (arbovirus) most commonly spread by infected mosquitoes. About 1 in 5 infected people will develop a fever with body aches, joint pains, vomiting, diarrhea, or rash. Less than 1% of infected people develop a serious neurological illness such as encephalitis or meningitis.



REDUCE YOUR RISK: ELIMINATE BREEDING AREAS

Mosquitoes breed in standing water. You can add to our efforts to prevent the spread of mosquito-borne illness by maintaining items in your yard that collect water.
